

SCHOLARSHIP FUND



PURPOSE

The Rolling Hills Foundation Scholarship Fund's purpose is to provide additional funding to existing scholarships made available only to students at Meadowbrook High School. A fund has been established through the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio for charitable donations to be deposited and then distributed based on the guidelines set forth in the Foundation's bylaws. Students who are awarded eligible scholarships may be provided with additional funds through this organization.

LAST YEAR

- The Fund included participation from 17 different scholarship sponsors. - Among the 17 scholarship sponsors, a total of 30 individual scholarships were awarded matching funds.
- \$13,325 in scholarship match funds were awarded to 16 unique students for the Fund's second year (compared to \$6,925 in the Fund's inaugural year).
