We hope that everyone had a wonderful holiday break with family and friends, but it's now time to get back to work in 4th grade math.

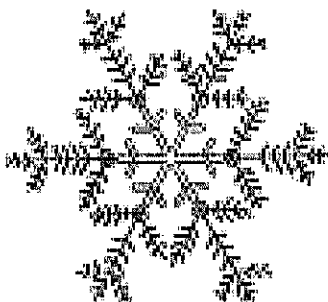
Within the next week or two your child will be bringing home a set of cards that will be on a ring. The set is to help you study with your child for the state test that your child will take this spring.

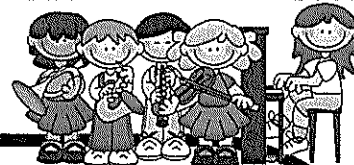
Cookie Dough Fundraiser

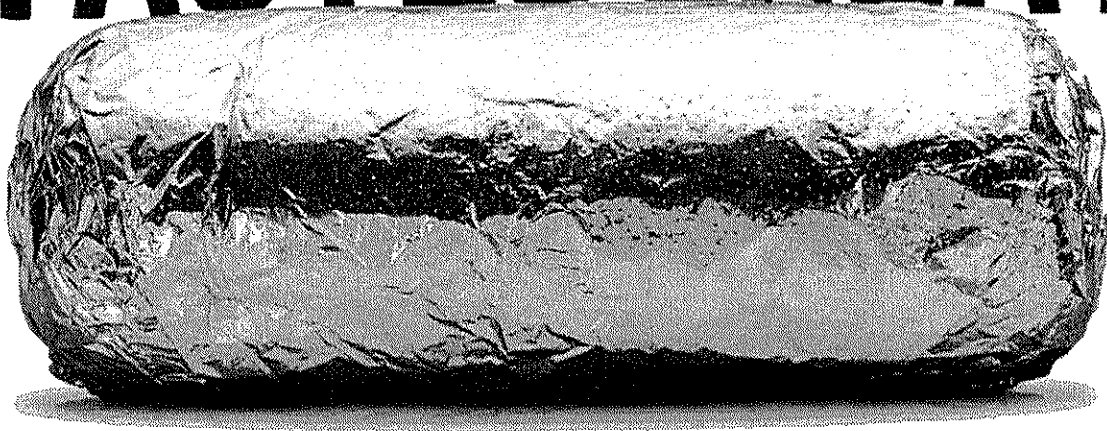

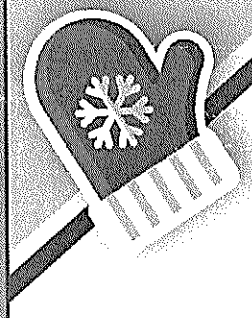
