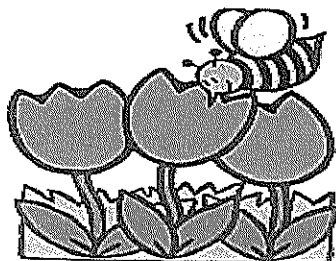

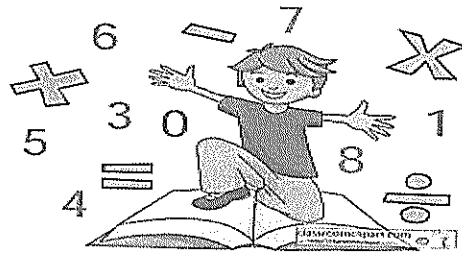

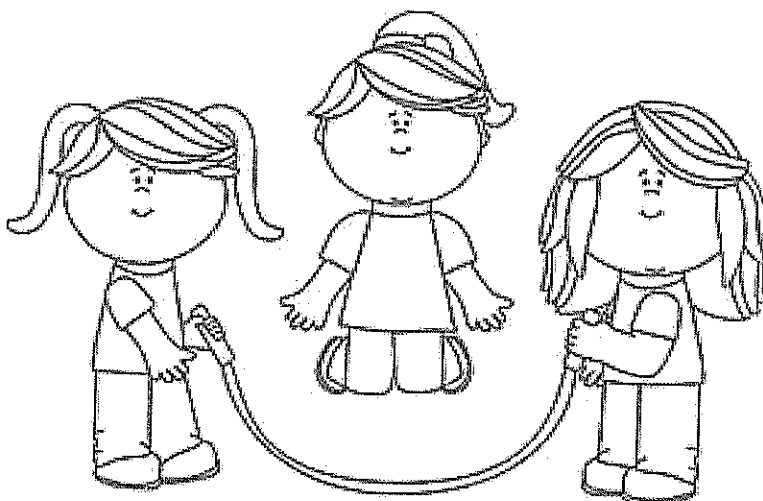


Jump Rope News

4th Grade Musicians

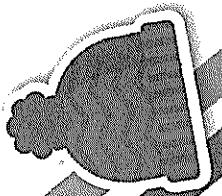
All regular 4th grade music classes have been learning to play the recorder. This musical instrument is most closely related to the clarinet and provides students with an opportunity to create music using different pitches. This is a wonderful starting place for students who are interested in joining band in 6th grade. So far, students have learned to play high D, high C, A and G. We will be diving into more notes in March. The program is based on improvisation with a focus on students creating their own music as opposed to learning traditional songs with letter names. We WILL learn some traditional songs later in the unit. If your student would like to purchase their own recorder, they are available for sale from Mrs. Wray. Recorders are \$4.50 and neck straps are an additional \$1.25.

5th Grade Musicians

All regular 5th grade music classes have been learning important music vocabulary to prepare them for continued music education in middle school. The terms we are studying are Tempo, Pitch, Rhythm, Dynamics, Tone Color and Form. Our lessons have included singing, movement, sequencing, listening, creating, playing games and Smart Board lessons and activities. We will soon begin learning our "Camp Songs" in preparation for the big 5th grade Camp trip at the end of April. Ask your student what they have learned so far!

3rd Grade Musicians

All regular 3rd grade music classes have been studying note and rest values and we are learning to read and write musical notation on the staff. Our goal is to be fluent in knowing the names of the notes on the staff using a comic book called "Rabbit Man Music". Ask your student if they can tell you our class saying for the lines and spaces of the Treble Clef.

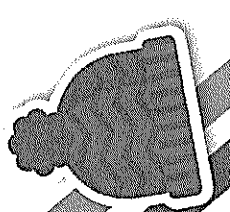
