 - <u>Last Name- P-Z-</u> 6:40 p.m.
 - Freshmen will receive their schedules, locker numbers and be given time to tour/explore the building.

 - Seniors can pick up their schedules from 8:30-11:30 or 12:30-2:30 in the high school office.

 - Juniors can pick up their schedules from 8:30-11:30 or 12:30-2:30 in the high school office.
- <u>August 13-</u>
 - Sophomores can pick up their schedules from 8:30-11:30 or 12:30-2:30 in the high school office.
