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# The Colt College and Career Center

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- Features two classrooms, a computer lab, collaboration areas, a “cafe” area, as well as several study and lounge areas.
- CCP students are given access to the space during class time and scheduled study halls
- These students have more flexible scheduling (i.e. studyhalls)
- Students whose grades drop below a C at reporting times will lose certain privileges until the grade improves.

# Next Steps for Students

- Accuplacer is administered each year in February
  - The date will be announced closer to testing via email, Google Classroom, and daily announcements
  - Students will sign-up at school
- Counselors present to classrooms about high school and CCP scheduling in March
- Courses are requested by students during individual scheduling sessions in March
  - CCP course offerings are subject to change year-to-year based on student interests
- Students must submit CCP Letter of Intent by April 1 and must complete the necessary college applications before leaving for summer break
  - The School Counselors will provide students with the necessary documents
